KEY EXAMPLE:
Noah had a FAITH worth
FOLLOWING

1. The FOUNDATION of Noah's
FAITH - *“being warned of God”*

2. The SPHERE of Noah's FAITH - *"things not seen as yet"*

3. The MOTIVATION of Noah's
FAITH - *“moved with fear”*

4. The EVIDENCE of Noah's
FAITH - *“prepared an ark”*

Gen. 6:22

Thus did Noah;
according to all that
God commanded
him, so did he.

Heb. 11:1

Now faith is the
substance of things
hoped for, the
evidence of things
not seen.

5. The EFFECT of Noah's FAITH -
"to the saving of his house"

Gen. 7:1

And the Lord said
unto Noah, Come
thou and all thy
house into the ark;
for thee have I seen
righteous before me
in this generation.

Gen. 7:7

And Noah went in,
and his sons, and his
wife, and his sons'
wives with him, into
the ark, because of
the waters of the
flood.

6. The TESTIMONY of Noah's
FAITH - *“by the which he
condemned the world”*

2 Peter 2:5

And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

Romans 14:23

And he that doubteth
is damned if he eat,
because he eateth
not of faith: for
whatsoever is not of
faith is sin.

7. The REWARD of Noah's FAITH -
"became heir of the righteousness
which is by faith."

Titus 3:7

That being justified
by his grace, we
should be made heirs
according to the
hope of eternal life.

Heb. 11:13-16

These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. 14 For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country. 15 And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned. 16 But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.
