Starting a Gospel Conversation

- 1) ASK: What is your CHURCH background?
- Give your TESTIMONY.

Starting a Gospel Conversation

- KEY: Never run down or be NEGATIVE about their church background. Be positive.

Starting a Gospel Conversation

- 2) ASK: If you were to die right now, do you know for certain that you would go to heaven?

Starting a Gospel Conversation

- if “Yes”
- Could you tell me WHEN you received Jesus Christ as your Saviour?
- How old were you when you were saved?
- WHERE were you when you were saved?
- WHAT did you do to get saved?

Starting a Gospel Conversation

- No (Or I think so, I hope so, I'm not sure)
- Understand: If they are really sure, they will tell you. If it's only a "hope" or "think", there is a great possibility that they aren't saved. This is a very sensitive moment, so be gentle.

Giving the Bad News

Giving the Bad News

- 3) ASK: Do you think you have kept the Ten Commandments?
- Have you ever stolen anything (no matter how small)?
- What does that make you? (Get them to admit, “A thief”).
- The 8th Commandment is “Thou shalt not steal.”

Giving the Bad News

- 3) ASK: Do you think you have kept the Ten Commandments?
- Have you ever used "God," "Jesus," or "Christ," as a curse word?
- Tell them that God considers this to be the same as blasphemy. The 3rd Commandment is "Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain."

Giving the Bad News

- 3) ASK: Do you think you have kept the Ten Commandments?
- Have you ever looked at someone and had lustful thoughts?
- The 7th Commandment is “Thou shalt not commit adultery.” Jesus calls says if whoever looks with lust has committed adultery in his heart (Matthew 5:28).

Giving the Bad News

- 4) ASK: If God were to judge you by the Ten Commandments, would you be innocent or guilty?

Giving the Bad News

- 5) ASK: Would you go to Heaven or Hell?
- “I don’t believe in God”
- KEY: STAY FOCUSED

Giving the Bad News

- 5) ASK: Would you go to Heaven or Hell?
- “I don’t believe in Hell”
- TEACH: the punishment for sin is HELL
